## LOUDON MUNICIPAL PARK NATURE TRAIL ADOPTION RULES

- 1. A minimum distance of 100 feet or a maximum of 500 feet is required for adoption.
- 2. Permanent structures, such as benches and picnic tables are welcome, but must be approved by the Director of Parks and Recreation.
- 3. Planting of non-native shrubs, plants, or trees only. Native plants are welcome.
- 4. Any modification or changing of trail design and layout is prohibited.
- 5. Maintenance of the adopted area must be provided by the person or persons responsible for the area.
- 6. Adoption is permanent unless notification is made by the person that they are no longer interested in maintaining the area, or the Director of Parks and Recreation feels the area has been abandoned. A yearly review will be made to determine maintenance.
- 7. Contact person for adopted area must be on file at the Parks and Recreation office.
- 8. Adoption of an area does not give any person legal rights of ownership.
- 9. All signs will be erected by the Parks and Recreation Department.
- 10. No obstacles or plantings can be closer than four (4) feet to the existing trail.
- 11. Park rules prohibit vehicles from parking anywhere except in designated parking areas.
- 12. Supplies and tools can be carried or wheel barrowed to adopted site.
